#### A Message From The Pastor . . .

### A Church that Prays Together

"...if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14

A few years ago, I was on a short-term mission trip in Eastern Europe, serving at an English Bible camp for adults. We were talking with our group about the state of things and life in general in that country, which had become a largely unchurched country over the last several decades. One of our discussion questions was about why so many people only came to church on Christmas and Easter, and what could change that. One of the ladies sat quietly for a moment, and then looked up and said, "There's a Bible verse that starts '...if my people, who are called by my name..." Prayer can change so much me, you, the way we each react to different things, even the world around us. Yet, how often do we pray before considering any other action? If we are being honest, it's sometimes the last thing we think to do.

Prayer is an essential part of living a Christian life of faith. Prayer is an essential part of doing life together as a Christian congregation. Prayer is not only how we communicate with God, but also how He communicates with us. It should never be the last resort in a difficult or any other situation, but always the first thing we do.

Yet, there are some who might be asking, "What exactly is prayer?" or "How do I pray?" or "Why is prayer really so important?" Those are all good questions and I'd like to take some time in 2024 to really dig into the necessity of prayer in our lives together as we follow Jesus.

The LCMC is once again hosting the annual Three Days of Prayer on January 2-4, 2024. I invite you to join in this intentional time of prayer, using the Lord's Prayer as your guide. Day One is focused on our Congregations and leaders; Day Two we will pray for all those who do not yet know Jesus, and for those who have turned away; Day Three will be focused on our international partners in the ministry of the Gospel of Christ around the world. You can find more information on the LCMC website at: https:// www.lcmc.net/three-days-of-prayer, and we will make available the prayer guides from LCMC. You may pray individually, or even in small groups if you wish, at your own time and pace on these three days. Our prayer room here at Zion will be available to you during regular office hours, and we invite you to come and spend some time in prayer here at the church.

Additionally, I will be leading a class, The Prayer Course, on Sunday afternoons at 3:00 PM, beginning January 7. We will begin with the basics of prayer - why and how we do it - and look at a variety of topics related to prayer. I hope you will plan to join me for this video and discussion-based class.

Let's be a church that humbly seeks the face of God in prayer, together.
